Previously Board vide Office Note No. 296 dated 28.09.2015 granted exemption of House Tax amounting to Rs.49,354/- for the year 2015-16. However, an amount of Rs.49,354/- remained as arrear upto 30.06.2015 as such exemption can be granted for one year only u/s 100 of the Cantt Act, 1924. The owner submitted application for exemption for the year 2016-17 in Sep 2016, the case was placed before the Board and the Board vide Resolution No. 34 dated 30.11.2016 "*considered and resolved to regret the request for being without merit*".

According to section (100) of the Cantt Acts, 1924, "***The Board may exempt, for a period not exceeding one year at a time from the payment of any tax or any portion of tax imposed under this act, any person who is in its opinion by reason of poverty unable to pay the same.***"

It is further pointed out that an amount of Rs.49,354/- as arrears and Rs.41,354/- for the year 2016-17 have been pointed out by the Audit authorities which have been converted in DPs.
